Learning this week:

This week we start our wild animal theme. Children will learn to identify wild animals, learn the sounds they make, their features and the habitat they live in. Children will be going on a safari trail to find the wild animals! There will be learning about animal patterns and making animal prints.



Talk to your child about:

- What wild animals can you name?
- What noises do they make?
- What features do they have?
- Where do they live?

Core Story:

This week's core story is 'Polar Bear, Polar Bear.' by Eric Carle. As well as learning about different wild animals and the sound they make, children will be answering 'What?' questions and retelling the story using story language.

Our Dragonfly children will be reading 'Dear Zoo.' They will be repeating phrases and filling in missing words.

Wonderful Word of the Week: 'jungle'

Each week, we introduce our children to a 'wonderful word of the week.' This week the word is 'jungle.'



Talk to your child about:

- What does a jungle look like?
- Who might live in a jungle?
- Wat sounds might you hear in the jungle?

Makaton Sign of the Week: 'sister'

Each week, we learn to sign a new word.

You can watch Mrs. Taylor sign it on our website (Learning Zone) so you can practice it with your child at home.

Poetry Basket: 'A Little House'

Every half term we learn 2 -3 short poems. This week the children will be reciting the poem, 'A Little House'.

Talking Tub

This week's talking tub and non-fiction books are about 'Tools.'



Talk to your child about:

- What tools are in the talking tub this week?
- How do you use the tools?
- What do the tools do?

Focus Song

Each week we learn a new song. This week the song is 'Walking through the Jungle.' You can sing along with child at home by watching it on https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=plvY0quSyJg

Our progression focus is:- sound songs

PSED

In PSED groups this half term, our theme is 'Managing Feelings.' We will be learning about different emotions. We will also be learning about road safety.

Woodlands

Each week our 3-4-year-olds go to the Woodland area.

Our woodland sessions are:

Ladybirds - Wednesday Bumblebees - Thursday Caterpillars - Friday

We provide warm jackets, waterproof legwear, and wellies for each child, but please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather and have a hat and gloves in the cold weather.

Work is completed on our 'Wonderful Woodlands.' This week the children will explore the new areas; den building, reading hut, mud kitchen and construction area.

Masterclass

Each half term, our school leaver children participate in a Masterclass. This term's Masterclass is Art Classes. The children will be learning about famous artists and creating artwork in the style of the artist.

On the 18^{th} March, we have a clay potter visiting nursery to make clay animals with the children and let them have a go on the potter's wheel! Look out for photographs on tapestry.
